My driver's licence was stolen/lost. What now?



A valid driver's licence is required for Mozambique. SADC citizens may use their legal drivers licence of the SADC country where it was issued.

If a SA driver's licence was lost or stolen prior to departure you need to you need to apply for the reissue of your driver's license and also apply for a temporary license at an extra cost. A temporary driver's license is issued on the same day and is valid for 60 days.

To get a replacement and temporary license, you will not be required to take a driving license examination, but you will undergo eye testing and your fingerprints will be taken.

As Mozambique does not accept a temporary driver's license, one should then obtain an International Driving Permit from the AA after obtaining the temporary driver's license. An International Driving Permit (IDP) is a legal document that endorses your South African driver's license.
